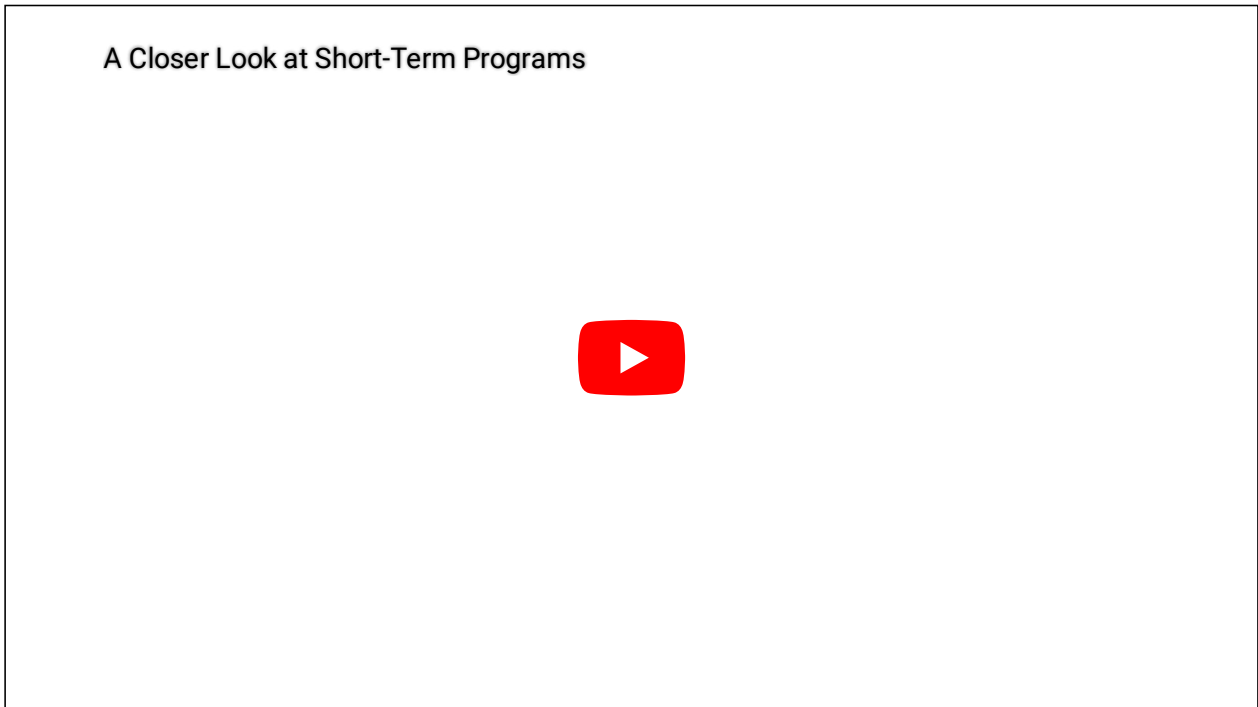


A Closer Look at Short-Term Programs
