

And suburban communities have been decisive in turning the tide against Trump and Republicans since 2016. Florida is no exception. Counties are classified as suburban based on a scheme from the National Center for Health Statistics.



» Democratic Support in Suburban Counties and Statewide




» Estimated Edu. Attainment of Likely 2020 Suburban Voters
