

# FISA Title VII Surveillance Requests

The rules governing surveillance of electronic communications done by the intelligence community or domestic law enforcement is based on four factors: the type of the information, the nationality of the target, the location of the information, and the location of the target. This flow chart is designed to help you understand how these rules form a regime that governs virtually all Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Activities (FISA), and identify how Section 702's structure allows the FBI to access a foreign intelligence database without a warrant.
