The process:



1. Application. Confidentially submit your resume and answer some short questions about your background, ideas, and motivations for pursuing a position in the White House and federal agencies, on Capitol Hill, or within Democratic campaigns.



2. Interview. A member of our team will reach out to discuss your experience, interests, and where you might fit across the federal government and campaigns.



3. Recommendation. Select candidates will receive a recommendation from the Moderate Talent Pipeline and be included on slates of candidates for key government and campaign positions. We'll work to help place recommended candidates in new job openings, shaping the future of government with skilled and dedicated individuals who are committed to making a difference for our democracy.
